

Enrolment at The Islamic College

Although you will enrol at and attend The Islamic College, the undergraduate and postgraduate programmes of study are validated by Middlesex University, and therefore you are a student of both. Within Middlesex University the programme is part of the School of Law. Being a Middlesex student a validated collaborative programme means, in brief, the following:

- If you successfully complete the programme you will receive the Middlesex qualification
- You may attend the appropriate Middlesex University graduation ceremony
- You do not receive a Middlesex ID card
- You are not a member of the Middlesex University Students' Union
- Your programme of study abides by Middlesex University Regulations which are available online at; <http://www.mdx.ac.uk/regulations>

Although it is not necessary to read the Regulations in their entirety you should know where you can find them and also be aware of the following key details:

- Appeals: You should be familiar in particular with the Appeal Regulations and Procedures (Section G) as The Islamic College and you have to act in accordance with these procedures if you submit an appeal:
